


About Poland

- Poland is a fascinating country that serves as the geographical and cultural crossroads of Eastern and Western Europe. Located at the center of the Northern European plain, Poland has been a nation of survivors since the foundation of the first Polish state more than 1000 years ago.
- Poland is located in the very center of Europe. it's the seventh biggest country on the continent. Polish population is over 38,5 million people. The capital city is Warsaw. Poland borders 7 countries: Germany on the west, Czech Republic and Slovakia on the south, Ukraine, Belarus and Lithuania on the east, and Russia on the north.
- Poland is placed in a moderate zone with mixed continental and oceanic climate influences. The average annually temperature is about 6-8 degrees Celsius while the rainfall is estimated at 700 mm.

- Lazarski University (formerly the Ryszard Lazarski School of Commerce and Law in Warsaw) a Polish non-public academic university based in Warsaw, founded by Ryszard Lazarski in 1993. The educational offer of higher education includes education at 3 faculties: Faculty of Law and Administration, Faculty of Economics and Management and Faculty of Medicine.
- The campus comprises six sectors (A, B, C, D, E, F) with classrooms, workshop rooms and lecture halls (the largest one, i.e. the auditorium named after Lech Falandysz, who since 1997 was associated with the then Ryszard Lazarski School of Commerce and Law in Warsaw, initially as pro-rector and since June 2000 as rector of this university.
- ❖ The Faculty of Law and Administration took 1st place in the 17th Ranking of Law Faculties of "Dziennik Gazeta Prawna".
- Lazarski University became a leader in the category of business education in the study "Trustworthy Brand", conducted by the publisher of the monthly magazine My Company Poland and the research institute Kantar Poland S.A. According to the prestigious Perspektywy ranking, they are ranked 4th among non-public universities in Poland.
- The high level of the medical faculty at Lazarski University was positively evaluated again by the Presidium of the Polish Accreditation Committee with the resolution No. 838/2023 of September 18, 2023.
- They cooperate with more than 90 academic centers around the world. Under the Erasmus+ program, our students can open up to new countries and different cultures. We offer not only student exchanges, but also foreign internships and placements. We develop our English-language study programs jointly with Boston University and Coventry University. As a result, studying one chosen major, students earn two diplomas Polish and British.
- They prepare our study programs in constant cooperation with top business practitioners. Each new specialty is supervised by an expert-mentor in the field. Classes are conducted interactively workshops, case studies, simulation games or projects provide the opportunity to learn through experience.
